On June 30, 2003, at 826 NW Murray Blvd., Portland, Oregon, Respondent installed an A.O. Smith boiler, National Board # 63942, for the account of another, without first having obtained a valid boiler / pressure vessel installation permit, in violation of ORS 480.630(6).

On or about June 9, 2003, the Respondent became licensed with the Division as a plumbing business, license # 26-313PB.

On or about September 4, 2003, boiler installation permit # IO3-24187 was obtained by a licensed boiler/ pressure vessel business for the installation of an A.O. Smith Boiler, National Board # 63942, installed at 826 NW Murray Blvd., Portland, Oregon, and the installation was inspected and approved.

Other Comments:

Respondent admitted the violation occurred and agreed to the entry of a Consent Order acknowledging a commitment to comply with the Oregon Specialty Codes. Compliance has been achieved in the matter. The Respondent was assessed a \$2,000.00 civil penalty. The Respondent will pay \$1,250.00, and the \$750.00 balance of the civil penalty will be stayed for a period of three years. The stayed civil penalty will be discharged at the end of the three-year period, provided there are no subsequent violations during the
