Valid installation permits were subsequently applied for and issued.

On July 16, 2002, the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services entered into a Consent Order with the Respondent in case number 2002-0215, finding Respondent in violation of failure to obtain a valid plumbing permit prior to installation. Respondent was assessed a \$1,000 civil penalty, Respondent paid \$500 and the balance of \$500 was stayed provided there were no further violations in the next three years. The current violations are a violation of the previous Consent Order.

Other Comments:

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By signing the Consent Order, Respondent has agreed to future compliance. Respondent has obtained the required permits and compliance has been achieved. Respondent was assessed a total civil penalty of \$10,500. Respondent will pay \$3,000, and the balance will be stayed for a period of three years provided there are no further violations in the next three years.
