Re: Manufactured Dwelling Installation Code Review Committee

The Building Codes Division is forming a code review committee regarding the adoption of the *2010 Oregon Manufactured Dwelling Installation Specialty Code (MDISC)* for an anticipated adoption on April 1, 2010. The MDISC is an amended version of the 2002 Manufactured Dwelling and Parks Specialty Code developed by the division.

This committee will review the code, any proposed amendments to the code, and then make a recommendation to the division. The next step in the process will be the division asking for a recommendation from the Manufactured Dwelling and Parks Advisory Board for the adoption of the 2010 Oregon Manufactured Dwelling Installation Specialty Code.

The MDISC was developed by the division to achieve the following goals:

- Stay within the statutory framework for manufactured dwelling installations
- Align the code with federal installation requirements
- Create a uniform and consistent Chapter 1
- Separate manufactured dwelling park construction from the installation code

If you or someone from your organization is interested in participating on this committee, the division is seeking the names of 1-2 people to represent your organization on the code review committee. If you were previously a member of the Manufactured Dwelling and Parks Specialty Code Review Committee and are interested in serving in this capacity again, you must resubmit your name.

The overall committee size will be 5 to 7 members. The committee will meet approximately 2 to 3 times at the Building Codes Division in Salem, the first meeting is planned for mid September 2009.
