8 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 10 1. On or about May 2, 2006, at 5033 NE Ainsworth Ct. Portland, Oregon, Respondent engaged  
11 in the business of installing a circuit breaker panel box, circuit breakers and ground rods, for the  
12 account of Bernis and Betty Dorsey, without an Oregon electrical contractor's license.
- 13 2. On or about May 2, 2006, at 5033 NE Ainsworth Ct. Portland, Oregon, Respondent  
14 installed a circuit breaker panel box, circuit breakers and ground rods , for the account of Bernis and  
15 Betty Dorsey, without an Oregon supervising or journeyman electrician's license.
- 16 3. On or about May 2, 2006, at 5033 NE Ainsworth Ct. Portland, Oregon, Respondent engaged  
17 in the business of installing a circuit breaker panel box, circuit breakers and ground rods, for the  
18 account of Bernis and Betty Dorsey, without first obtaining a valid electrical permit.
- 19 4. On September 11, 2006, Respondent was issued an Order of Corrective Action requiring  
20 that he retain the services of a properly licensed electrical contractor to obtain a valid electrical  
21 permit for the installations noted above and ensure that all necessary modifications or corrections  
22 were made to bring the electrical installations into compliance with the National Electric Code and  
23 approved by an Oregon certified electrical inspector. That Order became a Final Order on October  
24 9, 2006 and advised Respondent that \$1,000 per day would be imposed under ORS 455.450 for  
25 failing to comply with the Order. As of the date of this Order, the division has received no evidence  
that Respondent has complied with the Order of Corrective Action.

22 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 23 1. By failing to comply with the Order of Corrective Action, as set forth in the Findings of  
24 Fact, Respondent violated ORS 455.450 on five separate occasions between October 9 and  
25 October 13, 2006.
