9 Pursuant to ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Electrical and Elevator Board  
10 proposes to impose a civil penalty against Respondent, Pavel Crainic, in the amount of \$2,000.

11 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

12 1. During or about October 16, 2009, at 1185 NW 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Portland, Oregon, Respondent  
13 installed a bonding jumper from an electrical panel to a gas pipe, for the account of another,  
14 without a valid Oregon supervising or journeyman electrician license.

15 **APPLICABLE LAW**

16 1. Pursuant to ORS 479.620(3), a person may not, make any electrical installation without a  
17 supervising or journeyman electrician's license.

18 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

19 1. The installation of a bonding jumper from an electrical panel to a gas pipe, as set forth in the  
20 Findings of Facts, is an electrical installation under ORS 479.530(10).

21 2. By making electrical installations without a valid Oregon supervising or journeyman  
22 electrician's license, as set forth in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated ORS 479.620(3).

23 **ORDER**

24 Pursuant to ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, Respondent is assessed a \$2,000  
25 civil penalty for violation of ORS 479.620(3).

1 **NOTICE OF RIGHT TO HEARING**

2 Respondent is entitled to a hearing as provided by the Administrative Procedures Act, Oregon  
3 Revised Statutes, Chapter 183. If Respondent requests a hearing, the request must be made in  
4 writing and filed with the Division no later than 20 days from the date of service. If the Notice  
5 was served through the mail, the date of service is the day the Notice was mailed to the  
6 Respondent. If a request for hearing is not received within the 20-day period, Respondent's right  
7 to a hearing shall be considered waived unless the failure to request a hearing was beyond  
8 Respondent's reasonable control. Hearing requests shall be mailed to Building Codes Division,  
9 Enforcement Section, P.O. Box 14470, Salem, Oregon, 97309.

10 Respondent has the right to be represented by legal counsel. ORS 183.457 provides that a  
11 corporation may be represented by an authorized representative at the hearing. If Respondent  
12 requests a hearing the Board and Director will notify Respondent of the time and place of the  
13 hearing. The Board and Director will give Respondent information on the procedures, right of  
14 representation and other rights of parties relating to the conduct of the hearing before  
15 commencement of the hearing.

16 **NOTICE OF FINAL ORDER**

17 If Respondent does not request a hearing within 20 days, this citation will become a final order,  
18 effective 21 days after it was served on Respondent. If Respondent does not request a hearing or  
19 fails to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Division's file on the matter becomes record.

20 Respondent is entitled to judicial review of this Order. Judicial review may be obtained by filing  
21 a petition for review with the Oregon Court of Appeals within 60 days after the final order is  
22 served upon Respondent. See ORS 183.482. If the Order was served on Respondent in person,  
23 the date of service is the date Respondent received the Order. If the Order was served through  
24 the mail, the date of service is the day the Order was mailed to the Respondent. If Respondent  
25 does not file a petition for judicial review within the 60 day time period, Respondent will lose the  
right to appeal. The informational phone number for the Oregon Court of Appeals is (503) 986-
