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2 2. By allowing an unlicensed individual to make an electrical installation, as set forth in Findings of Fact, Respondent violated OAR 918-282-0120(1).

3 3. By making an electrical installation without a valid Oregon supervising or journeyman electrician's license, as set forth in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated ORS 479.620(3).  
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7 **ORDER**

8 Pursuant to ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Electrical and Elevator Board finds Respondent violated OAR 918-282-0120(1) and is assessed a \$2,000 civil penalty.  
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10 Pursuant to ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Electrical and Elevator Board further finds Respondent violated ORS 479.620(3) and is assessed an additional \$2,000 civil penalty.  
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12 The assessed civil penalties total \$4,000.

13 The Board, acting pursuant to ORS 455.775(2) hereby ORDERS Respondent to  
14 CEASE AND DESIST from further violations of the Oregon Building Codes, statutes, administrative rules, specialty codes, or any Order issued by a State Building Codes Advisory Board.  
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16 The Board ORDERS imposition of \$2,500 of the \$4,000 in civil penalties be stayed for the period of three years from the date of this Order, under the following terms and conditions. Failure to meet any of the terms or conditions contained in this order will result in the stayed penalty of \$2,500 becoming immediately due and payable.  
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19 Respondent shall not violate any provision of Oregon Building Code Statutes, administrative rules, specialty codes, or any Order issued by a State Building Codes Advisory Board.  
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21 If Respondent fully complies with the conditions imposed herein, the \$2,500 stayed civil penalty shall be waived at the end of the three-year period and no longer imposed. If the Board finds that the Respondent has violated any of the terms and conditions stated herein during the three-year period, the Board, by and through Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services, may impose the \$2,500 stayed civil penalty. Further, this Order does not limit the Board or Director from other actions to enforce other violations of the Oregon Building Codes statute, administrative rules, and specialty codes.  
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1 The remaining \$1,500 is due and payable after this document is signed by the Director  
2 of the Department of Consumer and Business Services or an advisory board. It shall be  
3 considered a failure to meet a term or condition of this order should a Final Demand for  
4 Payment be issued to Respondent and Respondent fails to pay the penalty within the  
5 time period stated on the Final Demand.

6 **CONSENT TO ENTRY OF ORDER**

7 I, Ted Longoria, state that I am or that I represent Respondent in this matter. I have  
8 read the foregoing Order and by my signature attest that Respondent knows and fully  
9 understand its contents; that Respondent consents to the entry of this Order and admits  
10 the allegations contained in the Findings of Fact; that Respondent has been advised of  
11 its right to a contested case hearing, and to be represented by legal counsel in this  
12 matter; that Respondent freely and voluntarily consents to the entry of this Order without  
13 further hearing, without any force or duress, and expressly waives any right to a hearing  
14 in this matter.

15 I understand that the Board may take further actions to enforce this Order or upon  
16 discovery of other conduct in violation of the Oregon Building Codes statutes,  
17 administrative rules, and specialty codes. I further state that Respondent will fully  
18 comply with the terms and conditions stated in this Order. I further assure the Board  
19 that Respondent will not perform work or conduct business in Oregon unless such  
20 activities are in full compliance with Oregon Building Codes statutes, administrative  
21 rules, and specialty codes.

22 I understand that this Consent Order is a public document.
