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## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The connection and installation of electrical wiring, as set forth in the Findings of Fact, are electrical installations as defined in ORS 479.530(10).
2. By permitting or suffering electrical installations to be made by a person or persons not licensed to make such installations, as set forth in Findings of Fact, Respondent violated ORS 479.620(6).
3. By making electrical installations without first obtaining a valid electrical permit, as set forth in Findings of Fact, Respondent violated ORS 479.550(1).

## ORDER

Pursuant to ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Electrical and Elevator Board of the State of Oregon finds Respondent violated ORS 479.620(6) and is assessed a \$2,000 civil penalty.

Pursuant to ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Electrical and Elevator Board of the State of Oregon finds Respondent violated ORS 479.550(1) but assesses no civil penalty. (An investigative fee was assessed by the local jurisdiction)

The civil penalties assessed total \$2,000

The Board further ORDERS that \$750 of the \$2,000 total civil penalty for the violation of ORS 479.620(6) be stayed for the period of five years from the date of this Order, under the following terms and conditions:

Respondent shall not violate any provision of Oregon Building Code statutes, administrative rules, specialty codes, or any order issued by the division or a State Building Codes advisory board.

The remaining \$1,250 civil penalty is due and payable after this document is signed by the Board. It shall be considered a failure to meet a term or condition of this order should a Final Demand for Payment be issued to Respondent and Respondent fails to pay the penalty within the time period stated on the Final Demand. Failure to submit payment will result in collection of the entire \$2,000 civil penalty.

The Board further ORDERS an additional \$500 be stayed from the \$1,250 civil penalty if Respondent remits a full payment of \$750 within 30 days of the date the ORDER is signed by the Board.

1 If Respondent fully complies with the conditions imposed herein, the stayed civil penalty  
2 shall be waived at the end of the five-year period. If the Board finds that the  
3 Respondent has violated any of the terms and conditions stated herein during the five-  
4 year period from the date of this stipulated agreement, the Board may collect the stayed  
5 civil penalty. Further, this stipulated agreement does not limit the Board from other  
6 actions to enforce other violations of the Oregon Building Codes statute, administrative  
7 rules, and specialty codes.

8 **CONSENT TO ENTRY OF ORDER**

9 I, KERI CROFT, state that I am or that I represent Respondent in this matter. I have  
10 read the foregoing Order and by my signature attest that Respondent knows and fully  
11 understand its contents; that Respondent consents to the entry of this Order and admits  
12 the allegations contained in the Findings of Fact; that Respondent has been advised of  
13 its right to a contested case hearing, and to be represented by legal counsel in this  
14 matter; that Respondent freely and voluntarily consents to the entry of this Order without  
15 further hearing, without any force or duress, and expressly waives any right to a hearing  
16 in this matter.

17 I understand that the Board may take further actions to enforce this Order or upon  
18 discovery of other conduct in violation of the Oregon Building Codes statutes,  
19 administrative rules, and specialty codes. I further state that Respondent will fully  
20 comply with the terms and conditions stated in this Order. I further assure the Director  
21 that Respondent will not perform work or conduct business in Oregon unless such  
22 activities are in full compliance with Oregon Building Codes statutes, administrative  
23 rules, and specialty codes.


