WHAT THE LAW SAYS

3 (1) Under ORS 480.630(1), a person engaging in the business of installing, repairing or
altering boiler or pressure vessels must possess a boiler contractor license issued by DCBS.¹

4 (2) Under ORS 480.630(5), a person required to be licensed under this section may not
5 install, alter or repair a boiler or pressure vessel unless an installation permit is first secured from
DCBS.

6 (3) Under ORS 480.632, a person licensed, or required to be licensed, under ORS
7 480.630 to engage in the business of installing, repairing or altering boilers or pressure vessels
8 may not employ any person to work on a boiler or pressure vessel unless the employed person
has a valid license issued under ORS 480.630.

ORDER

10 Under ORS 455.895(1)(c) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Board assesses the following
11 sanctions:

- 12 (1) a \$3,000 civil penalty for violating ORS 480.630(1)
13 (2) two (2) \$1,000 civil penalties for violating ORS 480.630(5) on two occasions
(3) a \$2,000 civil penalty for violating ORS 480.632

14 The penalties assessed total \$7,000.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO HEARING

17 Respondent is entitled to a hearing as provided by the Administrative Procedures Act, Oregon
18 Revised Statutes, Chapter 183. If Respondent requests a hearing, the request must be in writing
and filed with the Division no later than 20 days from the service date. If this Notice was served
19 to Respondent in person, the service date is the date Respondent received this Notice. If this
Notice was served through the mail, the service date is the day the Notice was mailed, not the
20 day Respondent received it.

21 If a request for hearing is not received within 20 days, Respondent's right to a hearing is
22 considered waived unless the failure to request a hearing was beyond Respondent's reasonable
control. Mail hearing requests to Building Codes Division, Enforcement Section, P.O. Box
14470, Salem, Oregon, 97309.

24 ¹ OAR 918-030-0010(8) states that for purposes of ORS 447.040, 479.620, 480.630 and any other
25 license regulated by ORS chapter 455, "engaging in the business" means to advertise or solicit, contract
or agree to perform, or to perform, work for which a license or permit is required under Oregon law,
including but not limited to a single instance.
