NOTICE OF PROPOSED LICENSE SUSPENSION
FINAL ORDER ON DEFAULT

RE: BCD License: 1341MDI and Civil Penalties in BCD Case # 2009-0147.

Our records indicate that you have outstanding civil penalties in the amount of **\$5,500**.

We have tried to contact you on a number of occasions to collect payment. Because you have not responded, the Division is proposing to suspend your license and deny any future licenses, pursuant to ORS 455.129 for nonpayment of a civil penalty.

You are entitled to a hearing as provided by the Administrative Procedures Act (chapter 183, Oregon Revised Statutes). If you want a hearing, you must file a written request with the Division within 20 days from the date this notice was mailed. Mail your request for hearing to PO Box 14470, Salem, Oregon 97309-0404 or fax it to (503) 378-2322. If a request for a hearing is not received within 20 days, you waive your right to a hearing. The Division's file on this matter will become the official record and the Division will take immediate action to suspend your license and enter a "Final Order on Default" without any further action or proceeding.

If you wish to appeal the Final Order on Default, you must file a petition for review with the Oregon Court of Appeals within 60 days after the Final Order on Default is served. *See* ORS 183.480 and 183.482.

If your license is suspended it is unlawful for you to perform work requiring that license; such violations are subject to a civil penalty up to \$5,000 per violation under ORS 455.895. If your license is suspended during your renewal period and you miss the deadline to renew, you may have to reapply and retest in order to be licensed.

Unless the penalty is paid in full, a payment plan with a stipulated agreement is the only other option that prevents your license from being subject to suspension and denied future renewal. If we suspend your license and then you establish a payment plan, your license will remain suspended until we receive the first payment.
