Proposed Residential Fire Sprinkler Requirements

Purpose of the hearing:

The division is seeking public input on proposed fire sprinklers requirements for residential structures. The division is [considering a proposal](#) to allow local governments to adopt fire sprinkler requirements for residential structures.

The [attached proposal](#) was reviewed by the Residential Structures Board on December 11, 2007. The public is invited to attend and to provide input and recommendations on the proposed installation standards, locations where sprinklers will be required, trade-offs for the installation of fire sprinklers, and local inspection fees and other requirements.

Those who would like to provide input may attend a public hearing on January 28, 2008 at 9:30 a.m. at the Building Codes Division, Conference Room A. Written comments may also be submitted to the contacts below.
