Net Metering and Interconnection

Purpose of the meeting:

The division, with the cooperation of the Oregon OSHA and the Oregon Public Utilities Commission, is holding a public meeting on net metering requirements that require sustainable alternative power utilities to provide a lockable disconnect for the safety of line crews working on the utility distribution systems. The division is conducting the meeting to discuss the requirements and brainstorm ideas that would promote consistency and clarification of the interconnection requirements.

The public is invited to attend and to provide input and recommendations relating to consistent statewide standards for net metering and interconnection.

Opportunity for public input:

Those who would like to provide input may attend a public meeting on July 2, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. at the Building Codes Division, Conference Room A. Written comments may also be submitted to the contact below.

Input protocol:
