**RE: Manufactured Dwelling Placement Permit Fee Decrease**

On July 20, 2000, the Manufactured Structures and Parks Advisory Board approved a temporary rule to increase certain fees in the Manufactured Dwelling Program. Among those was the State Code Development and Training and Monitoring Fee, which increased from \$30, to \$40, effective October 1, 2000.

Fee increases adopted by administrative rule, such as the one here, require ratification by the Legislature during the next session following the implementation of the fee increase. If not ratified, the increase is nullified, and the fee reverts to its prior amount. The increase in the State Code Development and Training and Monitoring Fee **was not** ratified by the Legislature, and will revert from \$40.00 to \$30.00 on July 1, 2001. All other fees which were increased at the time of this temporary rule will remain the same. We apologize for the short notice, but are following the mandate of statute based on the action of the Legislature.
