Plumbing Continuing Education 2005-2006

Renewal information for all holders of plumbing licenses

Reminder: Journeyman plumber licensing requires 16 hours of continuing education to be completed by April 1 of the year a license expires. Failure to complete required hours of continuing education on time will result in your license becoming inactive and may cause your license to expire. Once your license expires, you must reapply and test again to obtain a new license. It is *illegal* to work with an inactive or expired license.

You may complete the continuing education required for your license any time during your license cycle. Credit hours you earn that exceed the number of hours required for your license *will not* be carried over to the next licensing cycle.

Note: Only eight hours of continuing education are required for a solar heating and cooling installer.

Continuing education is *not* required for the following licenses:

- One- and two-family dwelling residential water-heater installer
- Water-treatment installer
- Plumbing business

You may check your continuing-education credits on the BCD Web site: www.bcd.oregon.gov. Click on “License Search” and then search by name or license number. Please allow three weeks for credits earned to appear on the Web site.

Plumbers required to wear licenses

Effective July 1, 2004, a new law requires you to wear your trade license when you are on the job

site, unless wearing it would create an unsafe condition. (OAR 918-030-0200)

Don't stand in line!

BCD launches new online services for permits and licenses

Saving time means saving money. BCD offers two new online services for contractors: electronic permitting, and license application and renewal. Both services allow you to apply and pay for a service from your home or office.

Online permitting: Building Permits.Oregon.gov allows contractors to apply and pay for over-the-counter plumbing permits in multiple jurisdictions through one Web site by using a Visa or Mastercard. Right now, plumbing contractors can get permits online for jobs in the site's participating jurisdictions: Hillsboro,



Portland, Milwaukie, Beaverton, and Clackamas and Washington counties. Minor labels, which contractors can use statewide, also are available through the site.

Online licensing: Journeyman plumbers can now apply and pay for licenses online. To access the system, use the PIN printed on your renewal notice. You will find the link to the "My License" system on the division's home page at bcd.oregon.gov. For more information, call licensing staff at (503) 378-2246.
