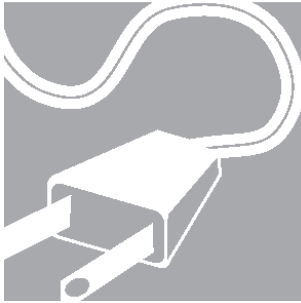

Electrical Continuing Education 2006

Continuing education requirements for all electrical licensees

Make your renewal process hassle-free by meeting your continuing education requirements well ahead of the deadline. BCD now provides a free correspondence course, in addition to courses scheduled by BCD-approved providers. Check BCD's Web page, bcd.oregon.gov, and look for "License Search" on the top of the home page to make sure that your continuing education credits are up-to-date.

Reminder: If you fail to complete the required continuing education hours before your license renewal date, your license will expire. It is illegal to work with an expired license.

Most licensed electricians must complete 24 hours of continuing education classes from a BCD-approved provider every three years to be eligible to renew their licenses. Eight of these 24 hours must be code-change credit hours. Licensees must complete a 2005 NEC code-change class by April 1, 2006, in order to receive code-change credit. Licensees who do not com-

plete continuing education requirements, including the eight hours of code-change credit, cannot renew their licenses. To qualify for a new license, individuals must submit a new application, pay all fees, and retest.

Exceptions

The following licensees are required to take only four hours of code-change classes:

- Limited contractor
- Building maintenance
- Renewable energy technician
- Journeyman sign
- Stage

All electrical contractors, licensees, and apprentices who obtain a license within 90 days of renewal do not have continuing education requirements. Licensees who obtain their licenses during the renewal cycle and licensees who teach electrical continuing education courses receive prorated credit hours.

Free code-change correspondence course now available

A new, eight-credit hour code-change course, designed by Building Codes Division's electrical program staff, is now available on the division's Web page, bcd.oregon.gov. On the left menu on the home

page, click on "Training and Education," then "Electrical." Students can earn eight hours of code-change credit until April 1, 2006; after April 1, the course is offered for code-related credit.

BCD online services

Visit BCD's Web site, www.bcd.oregon.gov, to link to a number of new electronic services:

- **Notify!** Sign up for regular updates from the division's code and other programs. To register, click on the e-mail subscription service on BCD's home page and choose from a list of options. When a Web page is updated, customers receive e-mails alerting them to the new code interpretation, publication, or other information requested. Notify! is an easy and painless way to stay informed.
- **Online license renewal:** BCD license holders can now apply for and renew their licenses online. The link to online licensing is on the BCD home page.
- **Online permitting:** Contractors can apply and pay for over-the-counter permits in six Portland-area jurisdictions — Portland, Hillsboro, Beaverton, Milwaukie, Clackamas County, and Washington County — online at BuildingPermits.Oregon.gov. A new shopping cart feature allows you to enter your credit card information only once to buy multiple permits from multiple jurisdictions.

Free continuing education courses

BCD's chief electrical inspector, John Powell, and assistant chief, Dennis Clements, hold code-change courses throughout the year in several locations. Check the electrical program page or electrical continuing education pages on BCD's Web site, bcd.oregon.gov. Click on "Code Programs," then "Electrical" for a list of courses.

The division's Tri-County Service Center offers three four-hour code-change classes in 2006 through its "Code Forums," co-sponsored by the National Electrical Contractors Association and the Independent Electrical Contractors. Sessions take place on Wednesdays from 4-8 p.m. at the Oregon State Office Building, 800 NE Oregon St. in Portland:
